



# SALT SMART, HIGH!




Grab a **free cup** and use it as a guide on when to salt and how much to use.

## SALT TO DE-ICE DRIVEWAYS & SIDEWALKS



**When to Use:** Salt **only** works when it is 15 degrees Fahrenheit or above. And it works best if applied **before the snow falls** or shortly after snow is cleared.

**How Much:** **12 oz. of salt** (the amount our cup holds) covers 250 square ft. (equal to 10 sidewalk squares).



### Stay in the S(k)now Tip

Sand in small amounts can be used for traction in colder temps



### Stay in the S(k)now Tip

Reuse excess salt! Excess salt should be swept up and either reused or disposed of.

## ROAD SALT $\neq$ GOOD FOR WATER

**Great on ice. Not in water.**

Excessive use of de-icer and salt on roadways, sidewalks and driveways can pollute our soil and water resources. Even small quantities can negatively impact drinking water, plants, fish and wildlife.

**Smart salt use during the winter can make a big difference!**
