



Stick & Puck Hockey Guidelines & Etiquette

Everyone entering ice arena must check in at front desk and pay.

- **These guidelines are for the safety of our customers.**
- **Those not respecting these guidelines will be asked to leave.**
- **No refunds.**
- **Maximum of 30 skaters on the ice.**
- Helmets required for all skaters. Skaters 17 and under must have helmet with mask and full equipment (USA Hockey standards).
- Skaters 11 and under must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- Skaters 11 and under: use lobby end of rink
- Skaters 12 and older: use scoreboard end of rink
- No parents or spectators allowed in the hockey boxes.
- Food and/or drink are not allowed on the ice - only water.
- Pass other skaters, no collisions.
- Everyone is allowed to skate regardless of ability.
- No contact! (i.e., checking, pushing)
- No sitting on the boards or nets.
- Report any dangerous situations or behavior to staff immediately.
- No formal pickup games - skills and drills only.
- Please do not litter or use foul language.
- Participants must always conduct themselves in an appropriate manner.
