Draft Feasibility Report Open House and Discussion

As part of the 2026 Pavement Management Initiative (PMI) the City is considering multiple areas throughout the city as candidates for pavement rehabilitation. As part of this consideration, the City is in the process of preparing a feasibility study combining all potential project areas. This approach saves costs and provides efficiencies. For the 2026 program, we have identified seven areas in total, with two of those areas being candidates for reconstruction due to the needs of the underlying roadway infrastructure and other identified deficiencies.

These two areas are Audrey Avenue/Upper 58th Court and the Blackberry Trail neighborhood. The City understands the impact that reconstruction will have on a neighborhood and will be having an open house to provide information to residents at the draft stage of our feasibility study so we can answer questions and provide information to residents on our findings at this stage.
